





- Coordinate with STAC, NTTAC, CMS PPS TA Center, and states to ensure alignment and non-duplication of TA

X We Do Not:

- Provide detailed education or compliance support related to state-specific requirements (states provide support)
- Primarily serve state officials, although officials are welcome to listen in on relevant offerings (STAC and CMS PPS TA Centers provide statefocused support)
- Support grant-specific requirements (NTTAC provides grantee-focused support)
