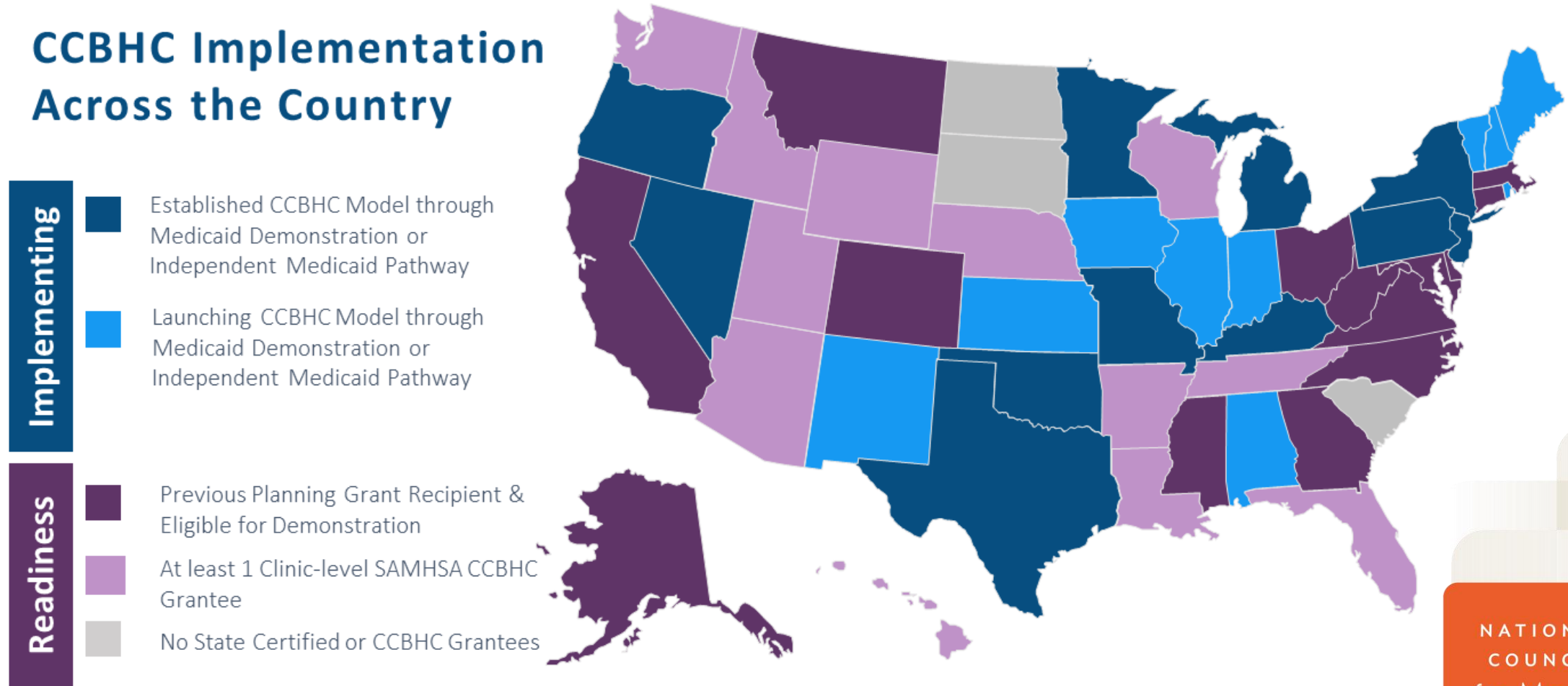

About the National Council

- And we **promote a greater understanding** of mental wellbeing as a core component of comprehensive health and health care.



What does the Success Center do?

✓ We Do:

- Provide general education on the federal requirements of the model
- Offer skill-building, best practices, recommendations, and other supports to help CCBHCs make the most of the model's opportunities and demonstrate success
- Encourage participation from a wide variety of interested stakeholders
- Coordinate with STAC, NTTAC, CMS PPS TA Center, and states to ensure alignment and non-duplication of TA

✗ We Do Not:

- Provide detailed education or compliance support related to state-specific requirements (states provide support)
- Primarily serve state officials, although officials are welcome to listen in on relevant offerings (STAC and CMS PPS TA Centers provide state-focused support)
- Support grant-specific requirements (NTTAC provides grantee-focused support)

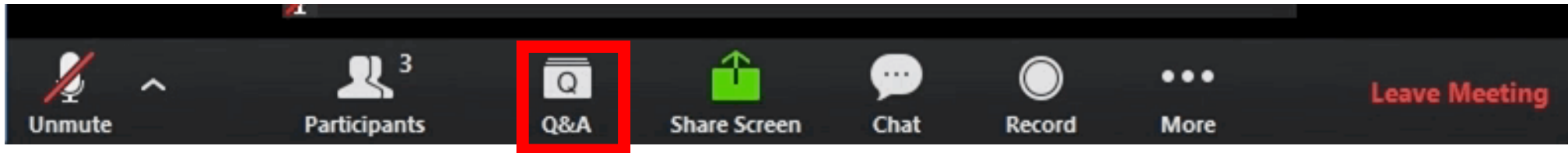

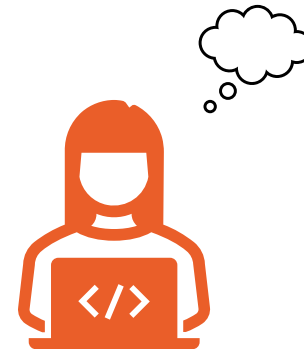
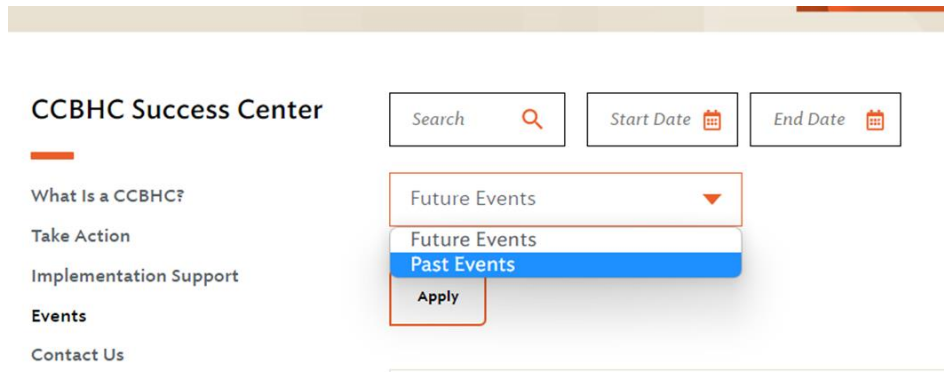
